When you register make it clear why you are objecting and what effects it will have on you, your family, your community or the environment. If you have professional expertise and are making technical / legal observations or challenges please make your credentials clear.

It may be best to prepare your objections in advance and paste them into the on-line registration (in 500 words or less). Once you have registered and submitted your representation you will be allowed to take part in the examination process. Whilst not obligatory, you can attend the preliminary meeting (where the examination timetable is set), submit a more detailed objection at a later date, or take part in any public hearings that might take place. Or you can do nothing further, it is up to you.
